March 2010

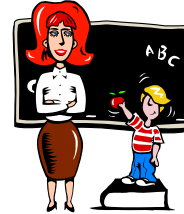
I asked the Grade R's who knows where they live, street addresses etc. Amena replies" I know, Home Sweet, Home"
